Households must utilize the food pantry designated for their zip code area, unless otherwise arranged. Provides one supplemental food box per month per household.

Supplemental Food box eligibility is determined on a self declaration of need based on the current 185% of Poverty guidelines. Additional Emergency Food Boxes are distributed on a case by case basis.
